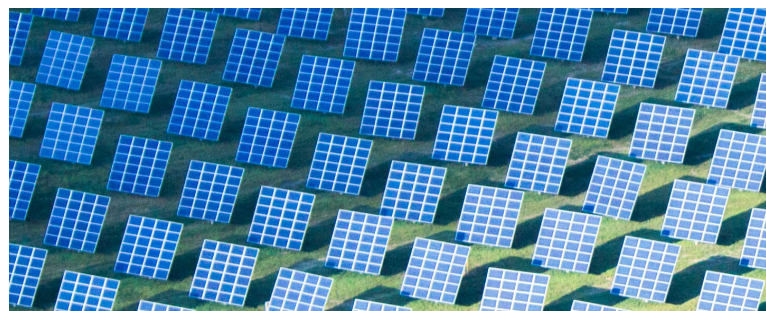




AllEarth Community Solar

AllEarth Renewables' Community Solar brings people and businesses together to share power from a nearby solar array with excess energy generation, through Vermont-sponsored net metering programs and using Power Purchase Agreements (PPA's). AllEarth provides Community Solar Members a no-cost-upfront option for energy consumers who may or may not own their home or business, or might not have a suitable solar site on their property. Members can choose how much power they want to draw from the array - enough to cover all electric needs, or just a portion.

Key Features

No Upfront Costs

There is no fee to participate, so you can jump right in and start using solar net metering credits from the array to offset your electricity costs.

Stability

Payments are locked in at the same monthly amount for up to 60 months, so members always know how much their electric bill will be, so there are no surprises. The Member is still connected to their utility company, but the monthly solar cost replaces the electricity that would have been bought from the utility - the utility just delivers it. Furthermore, as the utility company raises the cost of electricity each year, a Community Solar Member is immune to the price increases.

Flexibility

Sign up for as much power as suits your needs. A PPA locks in the initial discounted price for up to 5 years. The agreement can be trued-up and renewed at the end of each 5 year period. Moving to a new location and needing to cancel or transfer membership is not a problem.
